At the outset, after recitation of *Gayatri Mahamantra*, the Dean (Academics) welcomed all members and briefly outlined various agenda items to be taken up during this BOS Meeting. Then one by one the agenda items were taken up and in depth deliberations took place. Finally, the BOS resolved as follows:

- 1) The generalized framework for distribution of credits, as placed at Annexure-A, is accepted for all undergraduate programs running under the department w.e.f. the batch to be admitted in AY 2023-24.
- 2) With effect from the AY 2023-24 the current 4-Yr B.A. (JMC) program should be upgraded to 4-Yr. B.A. (Honors OR Honors with Research) in Journalism and Mass Communication with Minor in XXXX (where XXXX is the Minor opted by the students from a list of Minors approved by BOS). After completion of 3 years the students may choose either 'Honors' or 'Honors with Research' as per the applicable guidelines.
- 3) The detailed list of Major courses offered by the department, as per the framework mentioned in (1) above for the program mentioned at (2) above, with all relevant details as

desired in UGC notification on NCrF dated 10th April 2023 as well as UGC Notification dated Dec 2022 like LTP distribution, Notional hours, PSO, PO, CO etc., as placed at Annexure-B, are recommended.

- 4) The BOS considered various options for offering Minors by other departments to the students of the programs running by the department. The courses, as placed at Annexure-C, are accordingly recommended for specific streams.
- 5) The BOS considered and recommended the proposal of Minor, Multidisciplinary and Skill Enhancement (SEC) courses as placed at Annexure-D, which should be offered by the department of Journalism and Mass Communication to other departments of DSVV.
- 6) The BOS considered the Multi entry-Multi exit (ME-ME) model as recommended by UGC. It was noted that all the needful restructuring has been done by the department to enable these flexibilities. Accordingly, as may be decided by the higher body of the university, the department may implement the ME-ME.
- 7) The BOS recommended that across the departments generalized formula for generating program code and course code should be used. The proposal, as placed at Annexure-E, is recommended for the purpose. The Course code for the courses usually running in odd semesters shall be 101-150, 201-250, 301-350, 401-450 and for the courses usually running in even semester shall be 151-200,251-300.351-400,451-500. However, it may be noted that for any reasons if a course usually offered in even/odd semester course is offered in odd/even semester then also the same pre assigned code should be used. Same course must bear same code irrespective of the semester or the program in which it is being offered.
- 8) The BOS considered and recommended the proposal of offering ONLINE available relevant courses on various platforms (duly recognized by UGC) and the level assigned to these, as placed at Annexure-F. Further it is resolved that the department should continue this exercise of finding suitable ONLINE courses which may be offered after approval of VC/Pro-VC/Dean(Academics) on the recommendation of a committee consisting of the respective HOD and at least two domain experts (both of them may be internal persons).



 - 4) The BOS considered various options for offering Minors by other departments to the students of the programs running by the department. The courses, as placed at Annexure-C, are accordingly recommended for specific streams.
 - 5) The BOS considered and recommended the proposal of Minor, Multidisciplinary and Skill Enhancement (SEC) courses as placed at Annexure-D, which should be offered to other departments.
 - 6) The BOS considered the Multientry-Multiexit (ME-ME) model as recommended by UGC. It was noted that ail the needful restructuring has been done by the department to enable these flexibilities. Accordingly, as may be decided by the higher body of the university, the department may implement the ME-ME.
 - 7) The BOS recommended that across the department a generalized formula for generating program code and course code should be used. The proposal, as placed at **Annexure-E**, is recommended for the purpose. The Course code for odd semesters shall be 101-150, 201-250, 301-350, 401-450 and for even semester shall be 151-200,251-300.351-400,451-500.
 - 8) The BOS considered and recommended the proposal of offering ONLINE available relevant courses on various platforms (duly recognized by UGC) and the level assigned to these, as placed at Annexure-F.

Then the meeting ended with Shantipath.
