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MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

between

Faculty of Religion and Theology, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, The Netherlands

and

Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya University, India

In order to promote cooperation between the Faculty of Religion and Theology, Vrije Universiteit Amsterdam, the Netherlands ("FRT, VU Amsterdam") and Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya University ("DSVV"), the two institutions agree as follows:-

- 1. The two institutions will encourage direct contact and co-operation between their faculty and administrative staff, departments and research institutions.
- 2. Both institutions agree to cooperate in pursuing the following general activities in fields agreed by both institutions to be mutually acceptable:
 - a. Visits by and exchange of graduate and undergraduate students for study and research.
 - b. Visits by and exchange of staff for research, teaching and discussions.
 - c. Exchange of information including, but not limited to, exchange of library materials and research publications, complying with intellectual property regulations of both institutes.
 - d. Joint research activities: This covers scholarly research in several forms and more particular PhD research which will be considered in the following way:
 - i. Joint degree PhD research (the PhD student will be guided by supervisors of both institutions and aims to deliver one PhD Thesis for graduation which will take place either at the FRT, VU Amsterdam or DSVV). Upon a successful defense of the thesis, a joint degree will be awarded.)
 - This Memorandum is not intended to create binding or legal obligations for either institution. As and when details of any of the above activities are developed and mutually agreed by the institutions, such details will be set forth in agreements supplemental to this Memorandum.


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- 4. Nothing in this Memorandum shall diminish the full autonomy of either institution, nor should any constraints be imposed by either institution upon the other in carrying out any of the activities contemplated by this Memorandum.
- 5. Neither institution is an agent of the other, and neither has any right to act or represent the other, or to purport to do so. This Memorandum does not and shall not be deemed to create any partnership relationship between the institutions.
- 6. Both institutions understand that all financial arrangements necessary to carry out any of the above activities will have to be negotiated and that the institutions' ability to carry out any of the activities will depend on the availability of funds. This Memorandum places no financial obligations on either institution.
- 7. If no agreements supplemental to this Memorandum are entered into by the institution for a period of five (5) consecutive years from and including the date of the last signature signed below, this Memorandum will be deemed to have lapsed on the day following that five (5) year period. In all other circumstances, the institutions agree to review this Memorandum five (5) years from the date of the last signature signed below.
- 8. This Memorandum may be terminated at any time with the mutual consent of both institutions, which termination must be in writing and signed on behalf of both institutions. No amendment of the terms of this MoU will be effective unless made in writing and signed by each institution authorized signatory.
- 9. This Memorandum may be terminated by one institution giving the non-terminating institution six (6) months' notice in writing of the intention to terminate, provided that such termination will not affect the completion of any activity underway at the time or any previously advertised activity in which commitments to staff or exchange students have been made.
- 10. All communications must be sent to the address set forth below or to such other address designated by the institutions by written notice. Notices are effective upon receipt.

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Article /1/: Objective of the Memorandum

The aim of this MOU is to further discuss, explore and establish the principles and guidelines of research projects as outlined in this MOU, both bilaterally between Parties and multilaterally with other institutions. The outcome will be an agreement on the participation of the Parties in the establishment of an Expertise Center on Zero which will foster and develop scientific, academic and research cooperation as well as encouraging student and academic exchange between them on the basis of equality and mutual benefit.

Article /2/: Areas of Cooperation

Parties, within their available resources, will cooperate in the following areas:

- a. joint research projects and publications;
- b. exchange of academic materials and other information;
- c. participation in seminars, conferences, scientific activities and academic meetings;
- d. any other areas mutually agreed upon by the Parties.

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Article /3/: Exchange of Publications and Academic Documents

The Parties shall exchange their publications and periodicals under the intellectual property laws and regulations enforced in their respective countries.

Article /4/: Exchange of Support

The Parties shall undertake to support participants in the work programs by providing the information and facilities required for the cooperation and by settling problems related to organizing issues, in accordance with the enforced regulations in both countries.

Article /5/: Establishing the Expertise Center on Zero

The cooperation between Parties will ultimately lead to the establishment of the Expertise Center on Zero, as part of the Zero Project Foundation, but academically governed by the participating universities and institutions.

Article /6/: Dispute Settlement

Any dispute that may arise between the Parties regarding the interpretation or the implementation of this MOU shall be settled amicably by direct consultation and negotiations without involving to any third Party.

Article /7/: Final Provisions

- a. This MOU shall enter into force on the date of signing and shall remain in force for a period of one (1) year.
- b. Thereafter, it shall be automatically extended for a further period of one (1) year.
- c. Notwithstanding anything in this Article, either Party may terminate this MOU by notifying the other Party in writing at least three (3) months prior to termination term.
- d. The MOU will also terminate once Parties agree to continue their cooperation as mentioned in Article 5 of this MOU.
- The termination of this MOU will not affect any ongoing activities until their completion.
- f. Either Party may amend, change or add any item or article of this MOU by mutual written consent. These amendments, or changes or additions will enter into force according to the same procedure mentioned in paragraph /a/ of this article, and it will be considered as an integrated part of it.
- g. Each Party may nominate a coordinator (or a management committee) for the execution of the MOU within a maximum period of three months from its entry into force.



Article 1

The Parties, according to the existing legislation of the countries, will contribute to cooperation in the sphere of science and research based on beneficial interest.

Article 2

The Parties will contribute to the development of cooperation envisaged by Article 1 in the following spheres of science and technology:

- 2.1. fundamental and applied research in the sphere of humanities, arts and social sciences;

Article 3

- 4.8. establishment of joint scientific laboratories and centers.

Article 5

- 5.1. The Parties provide protection of industrial and intellectual property rights when cooperating based on the present Agreement.
- 5.2. Issues on the distribution of joint results of scientific studies obtained as a result of cooperation on the basis of the present Agreement or questions on utilization of other information obtained as a result of scientific studies as well as questions connected with patents, copyright, protection of samples and other rights to industrial and intellectual property will be agreed upon separately in every individual case by concluding Agreements between the Parties.

Article 6

In order to promote the objectives of the Agreement and control its implementation the Parties will appoint the coordinators responsible for specific areas of cooperation.

Article 7

- 7.1. This Agreement becomes effective from the moment it is signed by both Parties and is concluded for indefinite term.
- 7.2. The Agreement can be amended or terminated by either Party.

A written notice of termination and modification of Agreement should be sent not later than 6 (six) months prior to the supposed changes.

7.3. Amendments or termination of the Agreement will not influence the projects earlier initiated on its basis; their implementation will be continued on the agreed conditions.

Article 8

The present Agreement is concluded in two original copies, each one is in English languages, and both texts are of equal legal force.

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

ARTICLE 1

By mutual consent, this cooperation includes any program offered at either institution as felt desirable and feasible on either side and that both sides feel contributes to the fostering and development of the cooperative relationships between the two institutions.

ARTICLE 6

ARTICLE 7

Both parties undertake to observe confidentiality towards other parties not concerned or connected with this MOU. Any confidential information disclosed to either party pursuant to this MOU shall not, without prior written consent of the other party, be disclosed to a third party or be used for any purpose not expressly permitted in writing by the other party.

The confidentiality provisions apply to all confidential information exchange including any confidential information exchange in preliminary discussions and during negotiations relating to matters within the scope of this MOU.

ARTICLE 8

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MoU) between Foundation Maras Joks



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

THE UNIVERSITY OF THE WEST INDIES, ST. AUGUSTINE CAMPUS

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is made between:

The University of the West Indies, a regional public institution established by Royal Charter on the 2nd day of April 1962, through its St. Augustine Campus in the ward of Tacarigua in the island of Trinidad (hereinafter referred to as "The UWI") represented by its Pro Vice-Chancellor and Campus Principal, Professor Brian Copeland.

Dev Sanskriti Vishwavidyalaya, located in Haridwar, India. Established in the state of Uttarakhand in India through a special act passed by state legislature and also notified in the gazette on 11th April 2002 (hereinafter referred to as "DSVV") represented by its Pro Vice-Chancellor, Dr Chinmay Pandya.

The UWI and DSVV may hereinafter sometimes be referred to individually as a "Party" or "Institution" and collectively as the "Parties" or "Institutions".

WHEREAS

A. The UWI is a regional university of higher education learning and research, which has been charged with the mission of advancing education and creating knowledge through excellence in teaching, research, innovation, public service, intellectual leadership and outreach in order to support the inclusive (social, economic, political, cultural and environmental) development of the Caribbean region and beyond.

8. The UWI has its Centre Headquarters in Kingston, Jamaica and operates from the following Campuses: the Mona Campus situated at Mona in Kingston, Jamaica; the Cave Hill Campus situated at Cave Hill in Barbados; the St. Augustine Campus situated at St. Augustine and Debe in Trinidad and Tobago; the Five Islands Campus situated at St. John's in Antigua and Barbuda and the Open Campus which serves seventeen countries within the Caribbean region inclusive of the four aforementioned territories.

C. Whereas, DSVV is based on the teachings and vision of Pt. Shriram Sharma Acharya Ji, who was one of the ground-breaking Indian scholars of recent times. His education philosophy was to provide a free education to the deserving students with the contribution of the society and in turn, the qualified students should return the learnt skills back to the society in the form of a mandatory social internship. DSVV is working towards holistic education through its fully residential campus in Haridwar.

D. The Parties are desirous of collaborating across a range of projects, including but not limited to student / staff exchanges, research activities, joint seminars, conferences etc.

E. The Parties intend that to these ends the provisions of this MOU shall reflect the understandings and arrangements between the Parties and shall be carried out in a spirit of good faith and goodwill.

NOW THIS MEMORANDUM WITNESSETH as follows:

1. SCOPE

1.1 The Parties wish to engage in cooperative programmes of education and research, and promote exchange among their faculty and students. Accordingly, the area of cooperation shall include, subject to mutual consent, any activity or programme at either institution as considered desirable and feasible on either side to foster and develop the cooperative relationship between the two institutions.

1.2 The cooperation between both institutions will include teaching, research, exchange of faculty and students, staff development, etc., as deemed beneficial by the two institutions.

2. AREAS OF COLLABORATION

2.1 The collaboration shall be carried out, subject to availability of funds and resources and the approval of each institution, through such programmes or activities as:

- a) Joint research activities
- b) Exchange of Students (including research students)
- Exchange of Faculty and staff
- d) Joint teaching or supervision of students
- Staging of joint seminars, conferences and academic meetings

- f) Special academic programmes
- g) Education Abroad on the part of undergraduate and graduate students, including exchanges, internships, electives and practicum.
- h) Exchange of academic materials and other information where possible.
- Collaborative academic programmes which may involve cultural activities and a strong field visit component. These may be for groups or for individuals on Independent Guided Study Programmes
- Joint collaborative Grant Proposals
- 2.2 The terms of such collaboration and the necessary budget for each programme and activity shall be mutually discussed and agreed upon in writing by both Parties prior to the initiation of the particular programme or activity, and such programmes and activities shall be negotiated on a mutual basis. Each institution will designate a coordinator to develop and implement specific activities or programmes.
- 2.3 Each mutually identified and agreed activity, shall be covered by a separate agreement signed by both Parties; reference to this MOU shall be included.

The separate agreement shall specify the implementation provisions for each activity and indicate the financial arrangements to apply.

2.4 This MOU will not be construed to obligate any particular expenditure or commitment of resources or personnel.

3. PRINCIPLES OF COOPERATION

- 3.1 Implementation of this MOU will be in accordance with the Regulations and Policies of both Institutions.
- 3.2 The activities envisaged under this MOU will be carried out by the department of History of The UWI and by the office of the Pro Vice Chancellor of DSVV or through any other affiliated organization or nominee, mutually approved by the respective Parties.
- 3.3 The UWI and DSVV will each accept the participants selected by the other if mutually acceptable academic and/or professional qualifications and standards are met. The host institution will be responsible for making the final decision on the formal acceptance of participants in any exchange programme under this MOU.
- 3.4 All participants will be treated in the same non-discriminatory manner in carrying out the provisions of this MOU, subject to the provisions of the Regulations, Policies and requirements of each institution.

3.5 Any violation of these principles will be considered grounds for terminating the MOU.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY

Each Institution will protect the confidentiality of documents, information or data received from the other Institution as well as any other instrument concluded under this MOU. Any information disclosed by either Party to the other shall be treated as confidential information and shall be disclosed to only those individuals duly authorised by either Party to have access to such confidential information; unless such information is or becomes publicly available through no fault of the other or is disclosed pursuant to a legal or regulatory or reporting obligation to do so. Each Party's confidential information shall be held in strict confidence by the other Party using the same standard of care as it uses to protect its own confidential information and shall not be used or disclosed by the other Party for any purpose except as necessary to implement or perform the terms of this MOU. The obligations of confidentiality

shall survive the termination of this MOU and the Parties agree to return any document that

contains or reflect confidential information upon request from the other.

S. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

5.1 Materials and Data such as publications, software and designs owned by any Party may only be used with the consent of the other and for the sole purpose of carrying out an

activity/activities under and for the duration this MOU.

5.2 Notwithstanding Clause 5.1, it is expressly agreed that the Intellectual Property rights shall remain with the originating Institution and that no Party transfers by operation of this MOU

to the other Party any right in or ficense to any patents, copyright of materials such as

publications, software and designs or other proprietary right owned as of the commencement

of this MOU or arising outside of the research conducted under this MOU.

5.3 Copyright as well as rights to any other intellectual property developed jointly by The UWI and DSVV under this MOU shall be vested in both institutions. Each institution shall have full rights to exploit such jointly-owned works for non-commercial purposes, unless otherwise

specified by the Parties or formalized by a separate agreement between the Parties.

6. RESTRICTIONS ON USE OF NAME, ETC.

Both Parties agree to refrain from using any name, emblem, logo, trademark or other sign associated with the other Party without first obtaining the written permission of that other Party to do so. Further, this MOU does not grant either institution the right to use the other

institution's trademarks, tradenames or service marks.

7. PUBLICATION

- 7.1 In case the Parties wish to publish the results or output of any works or research arising under this MOU, they will both establish the conditions of the publication by mutual consent.
- 7.2 The Parties agree to provide each Party with a copy of the manuscript or abstract at least thirty (30) days prior to submission for publication in order to allow either Party an opportunity to protect any Confidential Information or Intellectual Property that might be disclosed by the manuscript or abstract. Any objection to the planned publication shall be made in writing within 30 calendar days after receipt of the notice. If no objection or consent is given within the time limit stated above, the publication will be considered to have been authorised.
- 7.3 The Party publishing the material obtained or developed from research and/or scholarly activities pursuant to the MOU shall acknowledge the contributions of the other Party to the MOU unless such acknowledgement is not desired by the other Party.
- 7.4 The Parties may contemplate to have a joint publication of the material obtained or developed from research and/or scholarly activities pursuant to the MOU. Appropriate acknowledgement will be made for the contributions of each Party.
- 7.5 Publication means the publication of an abstract, article or paper in an academic journal or other publication, including, but not limited to an electronic repository, print or digital media, social media platforms or its presentation at a conference or seminar; under this MOU, "to Publish" and "Publication" are to be construed as references to Academic Publication.

8. EFFECTIVE DATE AND LENGTH OF AGREEMENT

- 8.1 This MOU shall take effect from the date of the signature last affixed ("Effective Date") by the duly authorized representatives of the Parties to this MOU.
- 8.2 This MOU will remain in force for a period of five (5) years from the Effective Date and subject to the availability of resources. After the initial five (5) year period, this MOU may be reviewed and renewed by mutual consent every three (3) years.
- 8.2 Either Party reserves the right to terminate this MOU upon six months' prior written notice to the other. The Parties agree to make best efforts to finalize common projects and activities under this MOU prior to the effective date of termination.

9. REVIEW AND AMENDMENTS:

This MOU will be subject to periodic review and modification, as mutually agreed by the Parties. The Parties may modify or amend this MOU by mutual agreement in writing. A Party wishing to make a proposal for modification or amendment of the terms of this MOU shall do so in writing to the other Party no less than one (1) month prior to the effective date proposed for such modification or amendment. No modifications or amendments shall take effect unless duly agreed and signed by duly authorized representatives of the Parties.

1D. FORCE MAJEURE

No party shall be considered to be in default or in breach of its obligations under this MOU if the performance of such obligations is prevented by any circumstances of Force Majeure which arises after the MOU becomes effective. The term "Force Majeure" as employed herein means an event which is beyond the reasonable control of a Party and which prevents or significantly impairs a Party's performance of its obligations hereunder impossible or reasonably to be considered impossible in the circumstances or so impractical, and includes but is not limited to, war (whether declared or not), riots, civil disorder, epidemic, pandemic, quarantine, earthquake, fire, explosion, storm, flood or other adverse weather conditions, strikes, lockouts, or other industrial action (except where such strikes, lockouts or other industrial action are within the power of the party invoking Force Majeure to prevent), confiscation or any other action or authority by governmental or regulatory agencies or Acts of God. Any excuse from liability as a result of a Force Majeure event shall be effective only to the extent and duration of the event causing the failure or delay in performance and provided that the party relying on such excuse has not caused such event to occur and continues to use diligent, good faith efforts to avoid the effects of such event and to perform its obligations as reasonably practicable.

11. DISPUTE RESOLUTION

In case any dispute or difference shall arise between the institutions hereto touching or relating to any matter arising under this MOU, the institutions shall meet and attempt in good faith to resolve any such dispute or difference promptly through amicable negotiations. The institutions agree to use best efforts to utilize generally accepted alternative dispute resolution processes and procedures to resolve disputes and promote the spirit and intent of this MOU.

12. GOVERNING LAW

This MOU shall be construed, governed by and interpreted in accordance with the Laws of the Republic of Trinidad and Tobago and the laws of Republic of India. The Parties shall comply with all such laws in the performance of the obligations contained hereunder.
